

Silverhill Playgroup Policies and Procedures Updated at October 2015 AGM, updated November 2019

DISEASE	INCUBATION TIME (DAYS)	EXCLUSION FROM PLAYGROUP (DAYS)	EXCLUSION FROM CONTACT WITH OTHER FAMILY MEMBERS
Chicken Pox	7 – 12	7 days after onset of rash	None
Diarrhoea/Vomiting	Variable	Until full recovery, at least 48 hours after stopped	None
Measles	8 – 15	4 days from onset of rash and child is fully recovered	None
Meningitis	2 – 10	24 hours after completion of antibiotic treatment	24 hours after completing a preventative 2 day course of antibiotics
Mumps	12 – 26	9 days from onset of swelling; less if swelling has subsided	None
Rubella	14 – 21	4 days after onset of rash has faded and child has fully recovered	None
Scarlet Fever	7 – 10	Until doctor has confirmed fit; isolation may be terminated after 48 hours of antibiotic treatment	None
Whooping Cough	7 – 10	21 days after onset of cough and child is fully recovered	
Impetigo		Until child is fully recovered	None
Fifth Disease (Slapped Cheek Syndrome, or Parvovirus 19)	4-20 days	Until well	Pregnant women, if under 20 weeks, should inform the person providing their antenatal care as this can affect the unborn child,
Coronavirus (See our separate policy)	Approximately 5 days	Until fully recovered	Stay away from family and friends and as far as possible from same household members. Self-isolate for 10 days if you have symptoms.
